What is BioAccelerate?

BioAccelerate is a structured coaching program where you set the direction and your coach helps you get there. With a dedicated, expert-matched coach by your side, you'll have the time, structure, and accountability to make real progress on the strategic challenge that matters most to your venture right now.

Every venture's path is different. What you get out of BioAccelerate depends entirely on what you're working to achieve. Outcomes from past participants have included:

- Sharpening regulatory strategy and clinical evidence plans
- Building investor-ready commercial strategy and pitch positioning
- Clarifying core use case and competitive positioning
- Strengthening partnership and go-to-market strategy

Success – at your own pace

Who is it for?

BioAccelerate is for Jumar resident ventures who can clearly articulate a core strategic challenge or opportunity, and who are ready to commit fully to a structured coaching relationship over the program period. It's best suited to ventures that:



Can name a specific commercial challenge(s) they want to make progress on



Have a relatively stable foundation, so that challenge remains the priority over the program period



Have a founder or venture leader ready to commit to the full program



Are open to regular, honest coaching and structured accountability

Minimum eligibility: ventures must hold Tier 1 or Tier 2 (startup venture) status at Jumar and must not have previously participated in BioAccelerate.

One size never fits all

That's why the coaching cadence in BioAccelerate is set by you and your coach together – fortnightly, monthly, or a mix of both – whatever pace genuinely supports your venture's progress.

How does it work?



Kick-off meeting

Together with your matched coach, you'll unpack where your venture is today and where you're headed. Starting from the core challenge you identified in your application, you'll turn it into up to three commercial objectives and define these for a 2-year timeframe - where you're ultimately heading, and a 9-month timeframe - what this program needs to deliver to keep you on track. Each objective is paired with key results, so progress is something you can actually see and measure session to session.



Coaching

10 to 12 one-on-one sessions with your coach, at a pace you agree together. Each session is focused on your immediate priorities, progress against your objectives, and clear next steps.



Check-ins

Two formal check-ins with Jumar's Program Manager and General Manager at the program's midpoint and toward the end to reflect on progress, clear blockers, and connect you with further support if needed.



Graduation

Time to reflect on the journey and share your progress.



The application process



Expression of Interest opens late July

1. Complete the short Expression of Interest form by August 17
2. Tell us about the challenge you want to focus on and why now is the right time
3. Confirm who from your venture will take part



Expression of Interest closes in August

Our team reviews every application against our selection criteria and reaches out with a decision.



Coach matching in August and September

If selected, we'll match you with a coach suited to your venture's challenge and stage, and arrange an introductory meeting to confirm fit before anything is finalised.



Kick-off in mid September

Once your coach is confirmed, we'll get you started with a kick-off meeting to turn your challenge into clear commercial objectives and agree your coaching schedule.



Frequently Asked Questions

— How many people from my venture can take part?

We recommend one or two people participate directly in coaching sessions.

— Is attendance at every session mandatory?

All coaching sessions and check-ins are mandatory. If something comes up, you are responsible for rescheduling with your coach – just keep the Program Manager informed of any extended unavailability.

— Do I have to pay, or do you take equity?

Neither. BioAccelerate is provided as a valuable part of your Jumar residency.

— How is my coach chosen?

Coaches are matched based on your venture's challenge, sector, and stage of development, drawn from a vetted pool with a track record across prior BioAccelerate cohorts. You'll get a chance to meet your proposed coach before anything is confirmed.

— What if the cadence we agree at kick-off isn't working?

Coach and venture can revisit the schedule at any time. The model is designed to flex with what's useful for your venture, not the other way around. However, you must minimally meet fortnightly for the first 2 meetings and then at least once monthly.

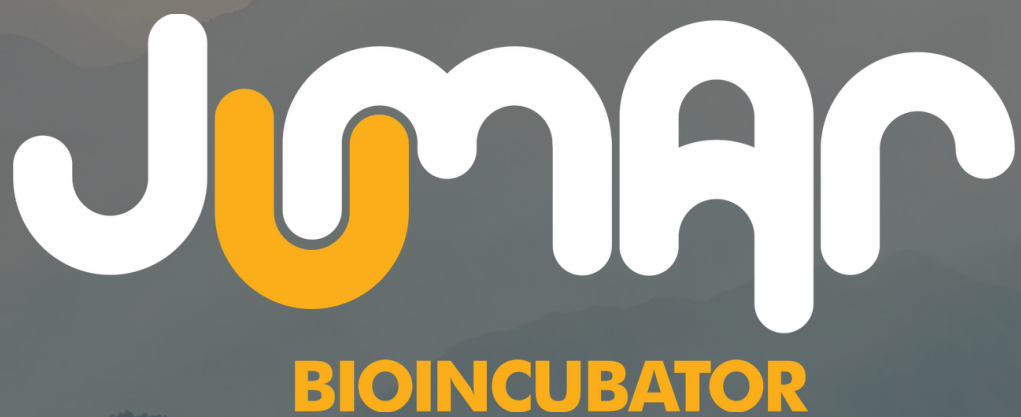
— How do you assess applications?

We assess Expressions of Interest against four criteria: coachability, time capacity and commitment, eagerness to learn and grow, and program fit. We're looking for ventures ready to engage fully, not just ventures with the most polished pitch.
